

Graduation Requirements

Middle school students (grades 6-8) are not on the credit system. They do not accumulate credits toward graduation from middle school to high school. They are, however, under certain restrictions as far as promotion is concerned. Following are the guidelines:

1. A middle school student must take and pass the accepted Florida curriculum of classes in order to move on to high school. Tracks One, Two and Three below reflect that curriculum.

2. A middle school student is required to take and pass **ALL** "core" courses. Core courses are the subjects of Math, English, Science, Geography and History. In the event one of these core courses is failed for the entire year, that course must be made up during the summer before entering school in the following year. If two or more of the core courses are failed, the student must repeat that school year.

3. All students in grades 9-12 must take a full schedule of classes each grading period. There are no study halls and only seniors will be allowed to serve as teacher assistants. Beginning in grade 9, a student will accumulate 7 credits per year. Following are the state minimums to be recognized as a:

Sophomore	6 credits
Junior	12 credits
Senior	18 credits

4. Following are the minimum curriculum requirements for graduation from a Florida high school:

4 credits of English with a major concentration on Composition and Literature

4 credits in Bible (1 credit per year of attendance at CH&BS)

4 credits in Math

Algebra I level must be attained for graduation

Algebra II level must be attained for entry into Florida four year universities

3 credits in science, 2 of which must be lab sciences

3 credits in social science which must include: 1 credit in American History, 1 credit in World History

1/2 credit in government and 1/2 credit in Economics

1/2 credit in Vocational/Practical Arts

1/2 credit in Fine Arts (Music, Art, Drama, Journalism)

1 full credit in either Vocational or Fine Arts is also acceptable for the Vocational/Fine Arts requirement

1/2 credit in Life Management Skills

2 credits in foreign language (2 consecutive years of the same language)

1/2 credit of Physical Education

*Two years of Sign Language may be substituted for foreign language.

*Participation on a school Varsity or Junior Varsity team (to its completion) will satisfy the Physical Education requirement for graduation and also will allow this athlete to forego the Personal Fitness class by taking the Personal Fitness Exam. This exam must be taken prior to graduation. The rest of the credits for graduation will be made up with electives. 27 total credits are needed for graduation.

Christian Home & Bible School is striving to offer as many Advanced Placement and Honors classes as possible in as many areas as possible. Please note track 1 for the Honors and AP classes offered at this time. Following are the special weights for those classes:

Honors 1/2 extra point per semester (Honors level courses are offered in all corecourse requirements)

Dual Enrollment (DE courses receive the same as AP weight for a 3-hour credit college course)

AP (1 full point per semester extra added to GPA. AP level courses will be offered in the following areas: English Literature, Calculus, U.S. History and Biology).

In order to graduate from Christian Home & Bible School as well as any other high school in the state of Florida, a student must maintain and complete their high school career with a 2.0 gpa. Following is the grading scale recently adopted by the state of Florida and now accepted by

CH&BS:

A 100 - 90

B 89 - 80

C 79-70

D 69-60
