- Slab evenly thick
  - Proper proportion
  - Smooth and well-glazed
  - Stylized details
  - Decorative hook on back for hanging

- PROCEDURE**
1. Roll out clay using guidesticks
  2. Drape over wadded newspaper form that is “face-shaped”
  3. Divide face up with tool into correct proportions
  4. Begin sculpting facial features
  5. Add raised and lowered areas to face
  6. On back of mask, hollow out thick areas to be same thickness as edge of mask
  7. Be sure to open mouth for “water drainage!”
  8. Create a decorative hook on back for hanging
  9. Fire and glaze with underglazes
